STOP DESCRIPTIONS

Shirlington Library

Start here to view the trees outside of the library.

Gravelly Point

Plenty of green space to ride through and sightsee.

Navy - Merchant Marine Memorial

Stop and sit at benches that overlook the cherry blossom trees on the other side of the river. If you're feeling adventurous, check out the Tidal Basin across the river in DC and ride along Hains Point and the National Mall.

Arlington National Cemetery

No riding allowed on Cemetery grounds, but you can walk around to view magnificent trees.

Cherrydale

Bike along the streets between Route 29, N Quincy St, and I-66. There's a reason this neighborhood is named Cherrydale!

Quincy Park

The library's grounds and Quincy Park host a few cherry trees and other beautiful blossoming trees.

Welburn Square

Welburn Square is one of our favorite places in Ballston to view ornamental cherries because of its beautiful design.
